For practising hypnotherapists the Professional discussion route to the HPD

The individual route to the HPD is via an NCH approved assessor (Carol Bain) where the candidate (student) uses the alternative method in the way their evidence is presented against the Learning outcomes to achieve the HPD (Hypnotherapy Practitioner Diploma).

Instead of writing up a lengthy document, the candidate prepares to meet with the assessor usually via telephone; this can be done with Skype, or conference call, the call can last anywhere between 90 minutes and 180 minutes, this will depend on the candidates ability to answer all questions through discussion by the assessor on their practice.

The assessor will discuss at length with the candidate what they know and how they currently practice against the learning outcomes.

To summarise;

- A structured interview with the candidate against the standards
- An opportunity for the candidate to demonstrate the learning outcomes through exploration, discussion and probing of practice and underpinning knowledge and principles
- A naturally flowing discussion rather than just a question and answer session
- A flexible way for candidates to evidence the learning outcomes
- An opportunity to use recorded evidence
- For a trained and experienced hypnotherapist, this is by far the most cost and time effective way to obtain the HPD.
